## **Laboratory Tests**

## **Benefit**

All laboratory and pathology procedures performed in any inpatient or outpatient setting are in benefit when ordered by a PCP, WPHCP or other managing physician.

## Interpretation

HMO pays for the facility charges for laboratory and pathology services (i.e., blood tests, cultures, frozen sections and pathology on specimens) for inpatient hospitalizations and outpatient surgery at a hospital or outpatient surgical facility. The professional component is the portion of the diagnostic procedures charged for the physician's services. If the IPA refers a member for laboratory or pathology services, and the lab/pathology provider sends a portion of the processing and/or reading to another lab/pathology vendor, the IPA remains responsible for all services performed.
